



UNIFORM SIZING

We recommend you take measurements for your uniform before you start the registration process. You will need size information to complete your registration.

When selecting sizes for your custom uniform parts such as uniform top and hat, please make sure you measure and consider the recommendations in the sizing guides below. Note that uniform tops in particular run small, and you will be wearing an undershirt and bibbers under them, so it is recommended you order up a size (or even 2). It's easier to make alterations to take in the top if it's too big than dealing with a uniform that's too small.

You will receive your uniform at event check-in. An alteration specialist will be available to help at check-in.

How To Determine Your Hat Size

Use a tape measure (or a length of string that you will have to hold up to a tape measure) to determine the length. Place the string or tape around your head about 1/8" above your ear, across the mid-forehead, completely circling your head. Hold the tape firmly, but not too tightly. Basically you need to measure your head exactly where the hat will sit. If your measurement falls between sizes, choose the next largest size.

1. Chest - Measure around the body at the fullest part of the chest, under the arms, and with the arms down and relaxed.

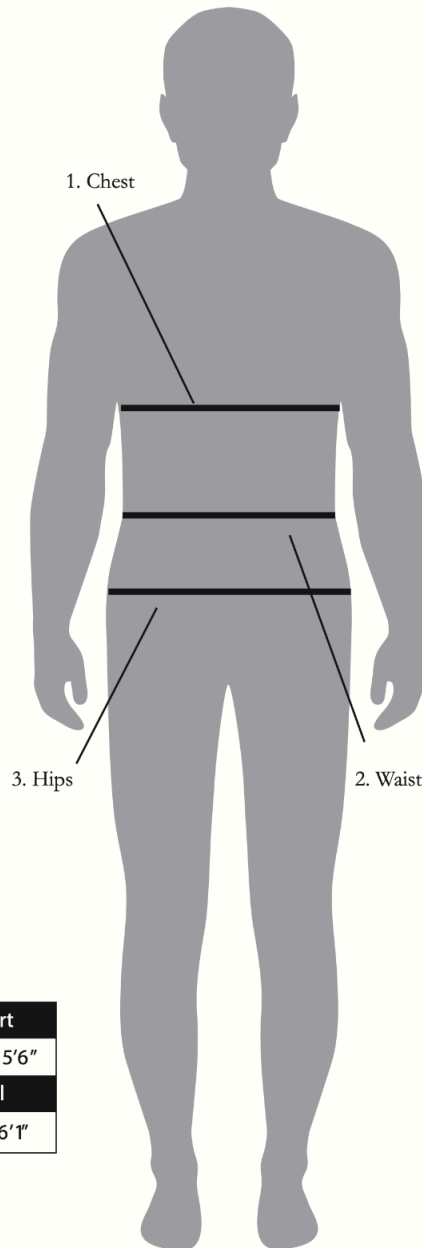
2. Waist - Measure around the waist just below the belly button.

3. Hips - Measure around the hips at the widest point.
