The number of scholarships awarded by the Boerne Champion FFA Booster Club is determined by the scholarship selection committee. The selection committee is comprised of members of the Boerne Champion Booster Club, Ag Science Teachers, Community Members, and/or Staff Members of Champion High School.

Applicants must meet all criteria for Boerne Champion FFA Booster Club Scholarship eligibility.

- I. Be an active member of the Boerne Champion FFA Chapter, with one parent/guardian being an active member of the CHS FFA Booster Club during the applicant's senior year.
- II. Be in good standing at Boerne Champion High School (CHS) and attend CHS for his/her entire senior year.
- III. Maintained a High School GPA of 2.5 or higher

A complete application consists of the following items:

- I. Application Form
- II. Typed essay, not more than one-page double spaced, original essay:
Topic: **Being a part of the FFA has impacted my life...**
- III. High School Transcript

Application Rules:

- I. Complete the application in its entirety.
- II. Handwritten applications must be legible by the reviewer. The board recommends completing the application using the online fillable template.
- III. Completed application printed, signed, and submitted to **your Ag Advisor and Boerne Champion FFA booster on or before 3 p.m. April 17, 2026**
- IV. Applications received after 3 p.m. will **not** be considered
- V. Incomplete Applications will not be considered.
- VI. Upon review of complete applications, the applicant will be contacted to set up an interview by the review committee which will last no more than 15 minutes.
