# **Faculty Updates**

#### **Band**

#### **Concessions/Volunteer:**

#### CONCESSIONS

- Have a presence (if not full concessions) at all concerts, theatre events, Shens, Radio Show, Tri-M Talent Show. Minimum a table with placards, donation option, spiritwear and a representative to welcome.
- Concessions makes a good profit now that we have it dialed in.
- Notify families about Shout-Outs in advance with ticket information.
- Make announcements in auditorium before the start of performance for concessions and shout-outs.
- Add additional Shout-Out stations along hallway for those waiting in line and in Lobby near ticket sales.
- Add Concessions in Lobby as well.
- Mix the shout-outs up brainstorm ideas candy, treats, other ideas?

#### HOMECOMING CONCESSION NOTES FOR NEXT TIME:

- Be specific about what we want donated insure that the message will go out through the administration with full details.
- Need both sides of Concession stand open.
- Need better signage
- Display what is available up high so kids can see and make decision before they get to the window. Pull item down when sold out.
- Okay that when it is gone it is gone.
- Gatorade, Soda and Izzys a big hit. No juice boxes.
- Water was an issue not enough stations. Go back to selling water bottles
- **IDEA**: cups with lids and straws fill with lemonade AT concessions. Put logo or date of homecoming on cup \$5.00 for souvenir cup \$1 refills.... Cold sensitive cups that change colors... or neon light ice cube.
- Snacks: Chips, candy, cookies all pre-packaged.
  - We purchased Nerds, sour punch straws, skittles, starbursts and oreos.
  - All \$1 or less per item sold for \$2 each.
- 4 volunteers enough for selling not room for more.

## Advocacy:

Goals for 2024-25 school year:

- Support the addition of Bulldog Buddy Choir for the 2025-26 school year
- Work with the counselors to have a Point Person for kids interested in pursuing Fine Arts in College

# **Fundraising for NY Trip**

Unable to continue the Cheesecake fundraiser since company no longer has storage facility

- · Currently students are selling Worlds Finest Chocolate
  - \$25 per box-credit goes to the student
- $\cdot$  Sell freeze dried candy-supplied by local business owner/parent, can sell bags for \$3-\$10
- Yard signs-purchase signs and proceeds go to each student or to M&T Sponsors-approx \$20
  - Art student contest for design of yard sign?
  - Talk to Ms Sarkady in Graphic Design class
- Briefly discussed online platforms for donations of money per student, pros and cons
  - Vertical Raise keeps 20% of proceeds
  - Raise Above keeps 40% of proceeds
  - o Entourage 4% surcharge for donor and if cancel trip do not get refunded
  - o Go FundMe or just collect donations on own from friends/family directly

# **Sponsorships**

Already process in place, will reach out to sponsors for past years and give them the first opportunity to sponsor M&T again

## **General M&T Fundraisers**

- Silent Auctions-on their own or combined with event like BINGO
  - Small business owners donate items for a raffle/auction.
- · Business fundraisers: Lou Malnatis (\$ raised per pizza), Portillos or Culvers (% of proceeds for all that make a purchase and reference M&T on specific day)
- BINGO is currently in the planning and approval stages, hope to host BINGO event sometime after January 2025
  - o 50/50 is possible but will need to follow ordinance process in Riverside
