Call to Order & Consent Agenda:

End of Year Updates

End-of-Year Reports & Old Business

<u>Summer Grant Report</u> – \$10,000 given away. 53 applied. Both are a record. Looking to see if the teachers have any ideas of how to award this differently. Need to figure out how to get more theatre parents to join. Maybe a push during the Fall Play in particular. Maybe in the future give lesson money during the year for master classes

<u>Year-End Financial Report</u> – Reports look a little different due to BoosterHub and the new tool is great! Has automated reports and other features. For April \$27,143, no income, it rolled over to May, \$1,566 in expenses \$500 Board forum \$26577 so that will cover scholarships. Raised \$8000 more than budgeted. \$2k used for scholarships. The plan is to purchase Live Streaming equipment for the music/theatre program. The teachers said they would talk with Matt Holdren to get recommendations for Live Streaming equipment.

Spending Votes:

- Motion made by Maggie White to approve \$5,000 to purchase Live Streaming Equipment, seconded by Liz Buoscio. Motion passed.
- Motion made by Amy Moran to approve a Summer Spending Budget of \$4,000 to cover various expenses, seconded by Ann Kissel. Motion passed.

<u>Riverside Arts Weekend</u> – RAW is June 7-8. Last year we funded a tent for \$500. Music acts from RB filled in between the artists that RAW signed up to perform. Lisa will help coordinate but cannot be there. Maple Jazz Trio and Dayne & Greyson will most likely perform. There are 3 slots on Saturday and 3 on Sunday. We are looking at Sunday. Last year we set up 2 tents and 2 tables.

Ad for the Landmark – Looking to put an ad in the Landmark informing the public on the grants given away. The cost will be covered by the Advocacy committee funds.

<u>Senior Banners</u> – Maggie will send a final email asking for money to cover the cost of the banners. The email will include instructions on when to pick up and how to send money via Zelle.

MTS will have info for families at new band member orientation about the parade and volunteering - to get some more/new people helping.

<u>Uniform Measuring</u> – Kelly thinks it should happen during the field show camp. It worked well last time. Having lists will help also.

Residency days in July – start communicating to students who got grants, they are required to take shifts. Others can still volunteer and get service hours. Need to come up with another swag item for those who sign up at residency.
