CHOIR - March 12 is the choir concert then Mads Jazz concert. Mads will grow by 2 next year. They are losing 10 treble voices and 4 tenor/bass. For the upcoming Hamilton field trip, they are waiting to hear if they can have a Q&A with a member of the Hamilton cast.

From Kelly - Future Bulldog night. We had a lot of questions and traffic. Course selection is on Saturday from 8AM - 3PM for registration. Kayley has the list of kids who have not volunteered yet but got scholarships. They might be able to run the tables for us.

Theatre Updates: Theatre fest was great! 6 students auditioned for colleges, which is a record. Sophie May ran opening ceremonies at Theatre Fest. Over 100 kids are involved in Legally Blonde with cast, crew, and pit. We will ask for volunteers, especially a graphic artist. Feb 14 is the deadline for Parent Ads. The cast party will be in Forest Park at a fitness center.

Curriculum - Acting and Directing never runs. They need to find someone to teach it! Would the administration consider an overage to allow it to run with Fuller teaching an extra class for a semester? If we had a zero-hour gym opportunity, it would possibly allow for Acting and Directing and for students to fit a Language in.
