## Competition Days

This is an overview of the different volunteer roles for a typical competition. Some roles may change depending on the schedule, or specific needs! Volunteers who sign up for a spot on BoosterHub do not need to pay an entrance fee for the competition.

Role	Clearance	Description	# of Spots
Competition Chaperones	Level 2*	Chaperones will travel with the students and provide supervision on the bus and during the competition. Accompany students from the bus to the equipment set up, to the warm-up areas, staging area. After the competition, accompany students to make sure they stow their instruments, get food and water, and when watching other performers. No students should be wandering the competition site without a chaperone!	8 volunteers
Stand By Chaperone	Level 2*	Fill in for above if needed	2 volunteers
First Aid Volunteer	Level 1	First Aid and CPR trained. Will travel with the students on school buses and during competitions	1 volunteer
Field Prop/Instrument Crew	Level 1	Volunteers assemble and disassemble props, load and unload props and instruments to/from trucks, push props and instruments onto and off of the field for performances and move props and instruments to various points around the competition site. Siblings middle school aged and up can also be utilized. Field Prop and Instrument Crew may serve in any other role, but may only chaperone as a last resort, as these volunteers should ideally arrive at the competition site before the buses.	15 volunteers
Cooler Crew	Level 1	Fill 2-4 large coolers and 3 small	2

Move cooler with band between trucks/practice area/field at competition site. Assist with serving drinks to students and parents after competition. Upon return to Western, empty and clean coolers to store for next time. Cooler crew may also serve in any other role.	volunteers	
Equipment Truck Driver	Level 1	Please volunteer if you are comfortable driving a 26-foot box truck. No CDL is required. The equipment truck driver may also serve in any other role except for chaperone. Pick up truck the night before OR the morning of a competition. Drive equipment truck to and from competition site. Return truck to rental agency.	2 - 4 volunteers
