Deadline to apply: 11:59 p.m. on Thursday, April 30, 2026. The completed and signed application, and a copy of unofficial high school transcripts must be received by the deadline. No late submissions will be accepted.

Scholarship announcement: Scholarship recipients will be chosen in a random draw and announced at the BHABC meeting on Monday, May 11, 2026.

BRIDGELAND HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

Each year at the May booster club meeting, the Bridgeland High Athletic Booster Club (BHABC) will award scholarships to athletes of the graduating senior class who have been active members of Bridgeland's Athletic Program and the BHABC. The application process shall commence in the Spring semester of the graduating class with the deadline established by the executive booster club board. BHABC Scholarships are awarded to graduating seniors to help them in their continued educational journey.

Eligibility and Qualifications:

- The applicant must be a Bridgeland High School Senior who is scheduled to graduate in the Spring of the current school year and plans on attending college/university the immediately following Summer or Fall semester.
- The applicant must be an active member of Bridgeland High School's Athletic Program, as a player, manager, or trainer and has a 4.5 cumulative grade point average on their Bridgeland High School transcripts.
- The applicant must be in good standing with the Bridgeland Athletic Program and Bridgeland High School.
- The applicant's immediate family must be a current, active member of Bridgeland High Athletic Booster Club, prior to the established scholarship deadline.
- The applicant must comply with the application deadline. The application must be received by the BHABC President on or before the established deadline by email. Email: presidentbhabc@gmail.com
- The application form must be completed and signed by the student.
- A copy of the applicant's unofficial transcript must accompany the application.
- Students that receive a full-ride scholarship are ineligible for the BHABC scholarship. Any athlete who has received (at time of application deadline) an athletic/academic scholarship that covers room, board and tuition for the following Fall *and* Spring Semesters is considered a full-ride and should not submit an application for the BHABC scholarship.

Policies and Procedures:

- The approved application form for the current graduating year must be used. No other application or form will be accepted.
- Prior to the May board meeting, the BHABC board will work with Bridgeland's Athletic Director and Bridgeland High School to ensure all eligibility and qualifications are met.
- The BHABC President will notify all applicants, by email, prior to the May board meeting that their application has been received and accepted.
- All Bridgeland High Athletic Booster Club Scholarships will be awarded by random draw and announced at the May BHABC meeting.
- A total of ten scholarships will be awarded: five female athletes and five male athletes. If less than five male or female applications are received, additional names will be drawn for a total of ten scholarships.
- Each scholarship will be \$1,500. The scholarship check will be made payable to the applicant.
