## Instrument Required Materials

The following list details required items per instrument. Families must purchase these on their own.

Your student must have these items by the first day of band camp and/or band class to be productive.

Flute	All flute players should provide their own instruments. Open hole flutes with B foot is preferred.
Clarin	et All clarinet players should provide their own instrument. Wooden clarinets are preferred with a Vandoren B45 mouthpiece.
Saxop	It is preferred that all saxophone players provide their own saxophone. Tenor and Baritone saxophones can be supplied by the school if necessary.  All saxophone players are required to provide their own mouthpiece; either a Vandoren Optimum or Caravan brand mouthpiece are preferred.
Trump	All trumpet players should provide their own trumpet. The Bach Stradivarius is a great start. All trumpet players are required to provide their own mouthpiece; either a Bach 3C or 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ C mouthpiece.
	h Horn/Mellophone French Horns and Mellophones will be provided by the school. All players are required to provide their own mouthpiece. The required French Horn mouthpiece is the Schilke 30. The required Mellophone mouthpiece is the Blessing Mellophone 6.
	All trombone players should provide their own large shank trombone with F attachment.  Bass trombones and Euphoniums will be assigned by the Director and provided by the school.  All trombone and euphonium players are required to provide their own mouthpiece; the Schilke 51D.
Tuba/\$	Sousaphone Tubas and sousaphones are provided by the school. All tuba players are required to provide their own mouthpiece. The Conn Hellenberg mouthpiece is the required mouthpiece for all tuba players.
Percu	All percussion instruments are provided by the school.  Snare drums must provide their own sticks after the second pair. We use the Innovative Percussion FS-PR exclusively.  Tenor drums must provide their own sticks after the second pair. We use the Innovative Percussion TS-PR exclusively.
