Marching Band Required Accessories

The following items are required materials for marching band participation. All band items listed below can be purchased from the band's online store in BoosterHub, except the black socks which you may purchase anywhere.

Color Guard members will get further directions on where to order their supplies from the Color Guard Director. The only item for Color Guard that can be purchased through the Band's website is the Uniform Water Bottle.

Please pay attention to ordering deadlines listed on the items in the BoosterHub store, as many of these items are ordered in bulk and require lead time for production and shipping.

Lyres and Cell Phone Clips - Woodwinds & Brass

You will need to be able to see your phone while playing in the stands at football games. If your instrument fully requires 2 hands to play or you don't think you'll be able to play with 1 hand holding your phone, they make cell phone clips to go on lyres. Some require standard lyres, others don't. Lyres are instrument specific and should cost less than \$10. I recommend buying a lyre from music stores like Sweetwater or Music and Arts, but feel free to make other choices. A few clip systems I've found that seem reasonable are below. These are not required for all but will make life easier.

- → Flip Folder app Instrument UniClip \$25 (requires separate purchase of a lyre, cleanest and simplest look)
- → <u>Tonal Innovation eFlip Version 2</u> \$25-\$35 (requires separate purchase of a lyre, clean look similar to Uniclip, does have the Version 1 at reduced price while supplies last)
- → <u>Gripophone</u> \$25-\$45 (does not require a separate lyre, looks bulky but more secure, brass only, potentially might not fit in a smaller case)
- → MobileLyre has instrument specific lyres (\$9-\$11) and phone-specific cases (\$22.50) that attach together. Website has a few with cosmetic imperfections at a reduced price

Flutes and Sousaphones - purchase the wrist holder version of these, as your instrument doesn't have a way to use a lyre. The <u>Flip Folder app Wristclip</u> is \$15, the <u>Tonal Innovation eFlip Model F</u> is \$30. Sousas, this is probably easier than a lyre if you'd like to be able to grip with the left hand while you play.

Trombones - the Flip Folder app T-bone Clip does not look very secure. Looks to me like the MobileLyre system is best for you, as it puts the phone along the lead pipe (choose small bore or large bore carefully, if you don't know and don't have a trigger it's a small bore). The Grip-O-Phone looks secure, but heavy as it attaches to the bell.
