- IHSA- changes to constitution and calendar
  - Softball can start a week earlier- to align with state championships
  - Deadweek has moved to the week of the 4th of July, June 29-July 4th, due to football season to accommodate 48 teams stead
    - Black and Blue will be Aug 20/21, with the Minooka Game, which can only play a varsity game
    - Will need a committee in the spring to prepare and include more teams
  - Co-op teams can not be done after this year is our enrollment is over 3500, so we can't compete as a team, but can as individuals
    - Work needs to be done to figure this out for gymnastics, water polo, and girls' lacrosse
