- **Pre-Orders: Total Pre-order sales were \$360 in sales**
- We are getting some individual sales through our online store which is positive. Total online sales are \$440.
- Based on cost and sale price these profit margins per item
 - Youth sweatshirt and Tshirt \$7, Adult T-shirt \$17, hoodies \$14, under armour hat \$10, garden flag \$12, winter hat \$13, blanket \$15
 - Consider slightly marking up cost at Black and Blue night to cover tax/shipping cost which equaled an additional \$2-3 per item. That cuts into profit.
 - Reminder that while everyone loves spirit wear it is not a great fundraising tool.
- Order placed for spirit wear to sell on black and blue total: \$3,221 (this includes the pre-orders from individual people). Small variety of items was purchased in limited sizes.
